7 Mayor Quintana called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was
8 recited. Council members present were: Rick Jennings, Silvana Lind, Gary Sporcich,
9 Nick Vigil, David Mockmore, Erin Jerant, Craig Lessar, James Moore and Mayor
10 Quintana. Others present included City Attorney Daniel Hyatt, Assistant Administrator
11 Beth Neece, Finance Director Dave Johnston and Treasurer Jacque Sikes.

13 **Executive Session**

14 Council member Vigil made motion seconded by Council member Moore to enter into
15 Executive Session to receive legal advise under C.R.S. §24-6-402(4)(b). Passed on a roll
16 call vote of 8-1. The “yes” votes were Council members Jennings, Lind, Sporcich, Vigil,
17 Mockmore, Lessar, Moore, and Mayor Quintana. The “no” vote Council member Jerant.
18 As City Attorney, it is my opinion that a part or all of the discussion of the matter
19 announced in the motion to go into executive session constitutes a privileged attorney-
20 client communication. I am there for recommending that no record be kept of that part of
21 the discussion which constitutes a privileged attorney-client communication. The City
22 Attorney has recommended that no record be kept of that part of the discussion in this
23 executive session which constitutes a privileged attorney-client communication. The
24 time was 6:09 p. m. and the tape recorder was turned off at this time.

25 Following the Executive Session *Mayor Quintana noted that if any person who*
26 *participated in the Executive Session believes that any substantial discussion of any*
27 *matter not included in the motion to enter into Executive Session occurred during the*
28 *Executive Session, or that any improper action occurred during the Executive Session in*
29 *violation of the Open Meeting Law, and asked, that statements concerning such be made*
30 *at this time. There being none, the Regular Session continued. The time was 8:16 p.m.*
